### Who and for how long ?

- Teenagers on semi-intensive one week language programs during the school holidays (Easter, summer)
- For a dinner, a weekend, a week or more

The family's native tongue must be spoken with the students in order to help him/her improve his/her fluency and comprehension

### How ?

One of IFLS staff will set up an appointment with you to meet you in your home in order to get to know you and to explain the homestay procedure.

Before the students' arrival, IFLS contacts eligible families to check their availability. Families are always free not to accept to host a student.

A prior homestay orientation takes place before students arrive

While the students are in the families, IFLS checks with the families on a regular basis in order to make sure that everything is going well for both the family and the student.

Information and advice on proper behavior in a family are given to the students on the first day at IFLS

Families get a daily financial compensation based on a half-board basis during week days and full-board basis on week-ends
